to improve the access of (14,898) children to schools, 7532 female students and 7,316 male students from the displaced and the host communities in the districts of Damt and Haifan in the governorates of Al-Dhalea and Taiz 2018-2019

Project outputs:

- Building Classess for education, with 24 classrooms In the targeted schools in haifan district and 16 classrooms built in damt district
- Providing the targeted schools with the necessary educational materials
- Building capacity of the teachers and education staff
- Distributing integrated school bags for students in both governorates
- Rehabilitate the toilete facilities of female school in both governorates
- Maintanance of schools furnitures of the targeted schools in both governorates

- Distribution of 13 wheelchairs for the children with special needs School in Al-Ta'iziyah District
- Supporting bus transportation to the School for children with special needs in Al-Taziah for 150 male and female students
- Providing training for 205 teachers in active learning and psychosocial support
- Implementation of the activity of psychosocial support sessions for the targeted students.
- Distribution of bags for students with their contents, 390 bags, for Al-Amal School for the Marginalized students .
- Distributing 205 bags for volunteer teachers with their contents.
- Distribution of recreational bags to the targeted schools, 58 recreational bags.
- Distribution of school chairs to the targeted schools, 620 school chairs.

To provide fishermen affected by the ongoing conflict with basic fishing materials to encourage them to return to fishing activity and to pursue safety at sea and to strengthen capacity expansion

Project outputs:

Implementation of training and capacity building for 800 fishermen (400 men, 400 women) on various aspects of the fish production
a number of 200 households of fishermen received tools and equipment, including (1600 fishing nets, 800 ice boxes, 2000 life jackets, in addition to 400 technical guidance manuals) for the purpose of motivating them to return to their main activity and main source of income which is fishing
